2. Officer Reports
 - a) President: Ashley Cizerle
 - i. **Teacher appreciation week was a huge success. A big thanks to Caroline Babington for organizing daily treats for JBD staff. They felt the love and appreciation for sure. It was so helpful to have school families contributing food donations to help keep costs down. The week ended with a PTA sponsored lunch. It was really great.**
 - ii. **Reflections/Scholarships banquet was a huge success. Our first in person meeting in the school in years. In addition to recognizing the students and scholarship winners, we voted on budget amendments. One of those amendments was increasing our gift to school budget to \$12,000. Part of that gift will be more Onie Tonie art. We are working with him to create directional artwork for halls. Likely using a specific sea creature per grade. We are also waiting on a quote to put a fence around the garden. The vinyl fence was way more than budgeted, so hoping for a wooden fence we can paint.**
 - iii. **Bingo night was also a great event. We had the perfect amount of people attend to fit into the cafeteria. Holding the event on a Saturday was great as far as setup goes. Presales for tickets was key – helped everything move very quickly and smooth.**

b) Treasurer: Wanda Wilson
Our account currently has \$72,793.82. We will be spending on gift to school, field day, moving on parade, and beach bash. To get everything in order as the school year comes to a close, everyone needs to submit reimbursements promptly. Wanda will be checking the PTA drawer in the office every other day for new forms and writing checks quickly. The last day of our fiscal year is the last day of June, but having everything by last day of school would be ideal. The reimbursement form is on the jbdpta website under the about us tab. Budget amendments: increase Benevolence by \$200 and add \$100 to open house line item.

c) VP Programs: Alanna Deal
After school programs are going well. Little pickup hiccup with SCA releasing at same time, but that was a one time thing and things are running smoothly now. Our new Oceanlife program is really cool, kids really like it. Our dance class will end with a performance so we will book the cafeteria for those dates. Wanda is getting invoices and has charitable donation tax forms for sponsorships.

The day will be divided into three groups- k/1, 2/3, 4/5— teachers will each get sheet with breakdown to the day, timing, activities, where to be, tent location

Each session will end with dunk tank and popsicles.

Volunteers are needed and those signups will be loaded into the volunteer tracker.
